

SCC Meeting Notes

November 9, 2017

In attendance: Angelica Ramos, David De Caro, Nicole O'Brien, Jennifer Koontz, Sandra Buendia, Miranda Harris, Kevin Moritz, interpreter.

Tonight Sandra Buendia from the district office explained the process Rose Park will be going through because they got an F grade from the state.

- We will be working with UEPC.
- UEPC will be doing an Appraisal at the end of November.
- The appraisal will involve interviewing students, staff, parents to determine what is working and where we can improve.
- They will then write up a report.
- From the report we will create a 90 day plan.
- A committee will be formed consisting of administration, a teacher chosen by administration, a teacher chosen by the superintendent, three parents, Sandra, UEPC, and our school board member.
- The process for choosing the parents for the committee is to send a letter home saying a committee will be formed and asking for those interested. SCC will look through the list of interested parents and choose based on demographics and any other key criteria.
- Meetings of the committee can be set up when the committee members can meet and the frequency of the meetings will be determined by the committee.

Sandra shared that the state is not funding any of this. The district is funding it for now.

She answered questions that the group had related to why grades drop, and how the support will look.

The support from UEPC is a four-year commitment. The goal is to develop a culture of continuous improvement.

The second and only other item was to take a vote on the Little Store, a fundraiser we want to do monthly at the school. Guidelines say this needs SCC and SIC approval. 4 voting members were at SCC and it was a unanimous vote in favor of doing the fundraiser.
