What Is "Shared Governance"

Shared Governance is Salt Lake City School District's (SLCSD) process for participatory decision-making. Although it is the exclusive right of the Board of Education to determine the goals and direction of the district, in 1974, the Salt Lake Board of Education agreed to delegate the right to

local sites to make some decisions through the Shared Governance process.

Shared Governance is based

on the philosophy that education is a responsibility of all employees and the community, and that when people work together to make decisions, many advantages accrue.

Shared Governance creates a sense of ownership and can empower participants to achieve great things. When people believe that what they think, say, and do make a difference, they feel a sense of pride in what they accomplish. Participation in decisions helps improve employee performance and success.
